

Grade 7 Class Policies and Expectations

Welcome to Seventh Grade! As teachers, we believe that every student can learn and enjoy this experience. This will be an interactive year. Our classes will help your child to develop skills in thinking, reading, writing, listening, speaking, and conducting experiments. We will work independently and in groups. It is expected that the students are respectful of others, put forth their best effort, and take responsibility for themselves.

Behavioral Expectations:

- Do not talk when others are talking. Talking that results in loss of instructional time will be considered defiance.
- Be in your seat when the bell rings. Not being in your seat will result in a tardy.
- Respect the rights of others and be respectful to others at all times. Do not touch or take things that do not belong to you.
- Do not sharpen a pencil, get drinks, etc. when the teacher is giving instructions, or when the class is engaged in conversation.
- All personal electronics must be off and in backpacks during school hours. This includes phones and smartwatches.
- All student handbook rules apply along with the expected behaviors found in the matrix on planner page 11.

Discipline Procedure and Consequences:

- Step 1: JupiterEd log to parents and students along with a verbal warning. This can be for any discipline issue.
- Step 2: JupiterEd log, detention, parent teacher conference, and referral to the office. This can be for any discipline issue.
- Step 3: Further discipline based on recommendations of teachers and administration.

Other specific discipline referrals can result in immediate consequences. See Handbook for more discipline information.

Grades: Students and parents may check grades any time via our online gradebook at <u>JupiterEd.com</u>. Parents and students who don't have login information will receive directions and temporary passwords through their English classes the first week of school. We encourage parents to set up automatic alerts.

Academic Honesty: All work submitted must be your own. Any work copied from a book, the internet, or another student, is plagiarism. Copying answers or using another student's notes is cheating. Allowing a fellow student to copy work, workbook pages or test answers is cheating. Plagiarism/Cheating will result in failure of assignment and disciplinary actions.
